Dr. Calimag is Professor of Basic and Clinical Pharmacology, Anesthesiology, Clinical Epidemiology, and Research Methodology at the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery of the University of Santo Tomas since 1986. She is likewise a Graduate Professor of Research Methodology, Translational Health Informatics, Culture and Bioethics, Human Behavior in Organizations, Leadership and Governance, Hospital Management and Leadership, Immunodiagnostics, and Therapeutic Drug Monitoring in the Masters and Doctoral Programs at the UST Graduate School. Her teaching also extends to her professional life as lecturer in the Pharmacology modules for the anesthesiologists of the Philippine Society of Anesthesiologists and the integrated Residency Training in the Anesthesia Review Courses; and in international symposia in the area of Pharmacology, Anesthesiology, Clinical Epidemiology, and Medical Education.

A prolific researcher, Dr. Calimag has published numerous scientific papers in national and international journals on various research topics such as pharmacology, cancer pain, palliative care, medical education, and interprofessional education as an author or a co-author.
