


AIDS During the Reagan Administration, 1981-1989








Discovery of HIV as the Cause of AIDS, 1983-84



AIDS Researcher Seeks Wide Access to Drugs in Tests

In a major shift long sought by those involved in the fight against AIDS, the chief of Federal AIDS research has called for a new system that would allow patients far greater access to experimental drugs.

Dr. Anthony Fauci, director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases, said such a system would provide promising drugs to some people with AIDS at the same time as the drugs are undergoing rigorous clinical trials. "I call this a parallel-track approach to clinical trials," Dr. Fauci said in a telephone interview.







HIV Replication Cycle: Targets for Antiretroviral Therapy






Reduction of Maternal-Infant Transmission of Human Immunodeficiency Virus Type 1 with Zidovudine Treatment

363 pregnant women given 5 AZT pills/day starting in 2nd or 3rd trimester + AZT during labor/delivery

Newborns given 6 wks oral AZT every 6 hrs

AZT regimen reduced MTCT of HIV by 2/3 compared to placebo




Vancouver 1996: Highly Active Antiretroviral Therapy Highlighted at IAS





President Block announced a new S500 million overretorial Momar and Child HV Prevention Initiative that seeks to provent the transmission of HV/A005 trans mothers to infants and to improve health care delivery in Africa and the Cartbbean. 

The President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief – \$15B Over 5 Years

Goals:

- Prevent 7 million new infections
- Treat 2 million HIV-intected people
- Care for 10 million HIV-infected people, orphans and other vulnerable children

PEPFAR Supports Programs in > 50 Countries



Total PEPFAR Funding: > \$110 Billion

Selected PEPFAR Program Accomplishments, December 2022

- 25 million lives saved
- 21.1 million people on antiretroviral therapy
- 5.5 million babies born HIV-free to mothers with HIV
- 64.7 million people tested for HIV
- 1.5 million people newly enrolled on PrEP to prevent HIV infection






